

Focus Therapy Services Covid-19 Protocol Phase I

Effective 05/11/2020

1. Curbside check-in and waiting area. Parents, guardians and transporters are asked to remain in the car for the duration of the session.
2. The therapist will go to the car and meet the client where temperature will be taken. If client has a fever, (100.4) they will not be seen and the therapist can recommend they see a doctor at the parents discretion.
3. Patients and therapists that can not social distance are required to wear their own cloth face covering while in the clinic during appointments. Face coverings should not be placed on children under the age of 2.
4. When the client enters the clinic, they will be taken to wash their hands immediately before starting or use hand sanitizer.
5. At the end of the session, the therapists will escort client to the car and talk with parent about the session.
6. Therapists will properly disinfect tabletops after each session and all toys at the end of the day. Water Play and Sensory play (Beans, Rice, Sand, Ball Pit) is prohibited. For clients using Play-doh, an individual container will be given to the child and labeled with his/her name.
7. If a client or staff uses the restroom, Lysol will be sprayed after each restroom visit as well as proper hand washing. (Over 20 seconds with soap and water)
8. Employees must wash hands often and after each client session.
09. Employees that spend one on one time with a client will also be required to wear a mask when social distancing is not able to be maintained. Social distancing is described by being SIX FEET apart anytime over 10 minutes.
